

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity.

In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

You may notice contradictions in your report; these reflect the complexities of the human condition. For instance, your dynamic together might in some situations be quite active, but in others less so. While your chart may provide helpful insights, it cannot predict the future. You are ultimately the master of your own fate.

Chart Patterns

Grand Trine

You have a Grand Trine in your chart. When three or more of your planets form a Grand Trine with each other, you will have an exceptional area of talent represented by the element in the trine, either Fire, Earth, Air or Water (usually these planets are in just one element). You will display a marked self-sufficiency and also will have good success in your endeavors in this area of life. You must also beware, however, of being lazy or complacent.

Grand Cross

You have a Grand Cross in your chart. At least four planets in your chart form a Grand Cross, in square with one another. Each planet in the pattern therefore becomes the focus of a 'T-Square'. With this pattern you have unusual determination and force of will. You will almost invariably suffer great trials in your life, and these trials will build your character. You will be able to rise above your circumstances to exceptional achievement in the areas represented by the four corners of the cross.

T-Square, focal planet(s) Mars, Rising

You have a T-Square in your chart. With this planetary aspect pattern, in which three planets or conjunctions are in square with one another, you have a high degree of motivation and drive. Your energies are most easily and habitually expressed by the energy of the focal point, the middle of the T-Square. You may also compensate for overdoing in the area of life represented by the focal point, by leaning toward the empty pattern element opposite the focal point, seeking to balance your activity. The lesson of this planetary aspect pattern is in learning to use your considerable energy wisely in the pursuit of your true goals. There is great tension represented by the focal planet or planets in your chart, where conflicting parts of your personality attain their focus and peak of energy, and you may observe compulsive behavior in the area of life represented here.

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

Mars in the Eleventh House (or sign) brings out an idealistic, socially oriented and multidimensional drive in your relationship. This placement can take out the rough edges that each of you may individually harbor and bring you together in a way that benefits both the partnership and the greater world that surrounds you. You two tend to co-create in an

enterprising and ambitious way and make classic teammates working together toward socially life-enhancing goals. In a romantic relationship, you may need to become aware of the way you direct your shared activity, giving priority time to your personal issues as well as planetary goals, so that your partnership rests on a sturdy foundation. You are likely to be friends as well as lovers, which enhances your bond with each other although it may dim your passion. Together you easily tolerate each other's differences and support each other's goals so that in the best of your connection with each other, you move to the clear beat of the same drummer.

Mars in Gemini (or the third house) brings an alert, witty and energetic drive to your relationship. You two are adventurous and physically active together, with a gift for quickly adapting to changing circumstances. Your connection brings out the talkative and communicative side of each of you. Glib in speech, you get your ideas across very well with each other and with those around you, although you may be better talkers than listeners. You bring life to new ideas. If the relationship has any weaknesses in this area, it is in a tendency for you to be somewhat sharp with each other, or possibly indulge in gossip together. In a romantic relationship you find that talking is almost as good as physical interaction and that sex is boring without it. On the positive side, you will find you can communicate together regarding just about anything, and also make good facilitators when working with others. Together, you possess a natural mechanical ability and do many things well. You might benefit by learning to apply more focus and better concentration to your shared energies.

Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

Pluto in the Eleventh House (or sign) correlates to a relationship with a powerful focus on social orientation and your shared goals, with the net effect of transforming this area of your lives together. As a partnership, you may have fears or deep emotional needs around the issue of group participation. You may find hidden emotional currents between you in the area of friendships and membership in one form of group or another, or in relation to social goals that you each espouse, and you also may be very loyal to each other and consider yourselves in an important social grouping of two. There also may clashes of will between you over the direction that the relationship is to take. In a romantic relationship, a compulsion of some form may exist in which you tend to submerge yourself in the relationship. There may also be power struggles to contend with that relate to your own deeper issues or your feelings of self-esteem and self-expression, as individuals. Composite Pluto in Gemini (or the third house) brings forth in your relationship a shared set of unusually clear and direct communication skills. There may be a quality of compulsion to your desires for forceful communication, and you will learn much about yourselves both in relationship and individually as you explore the issues that arise in this area. In a romantic relationship, there can be verbal battles for the sake of the battle, and you benefit when you learn to look past the obvious and more deeply into yourselves, individually, as the ultimate source of the conflict. When you do, the realizations are powerful and may change your life forever from the inside out. The biggest danger occurs when one or the other of you resists the growth that is your evolutionary mandate with this placement. Continuing to inhabit stuck positions only escalates the conflict. On the other hand, stuffing your feelings down because you think that it serves the cause of harmony to do so may only build energy for the eventual explosion. You win when you can shift your focus out of so-called reasoning and into a more intuitive process that takes you inside yourselves to become better acquainted with the nature and quality of your compulsions, and your resistance. T-Square, focal planet(s) Sun

In sum, this position is excellent for material achievement, and tends to emphasize the pragmatic. The relationship works well for business-centered partnerships, and asks those in more personal contexts to develop additional ways of connecting to ensure longevity.

The Composite Sun in Libra indicates a relationship that centers on the principles of harmony and beauty. Libra is the sign of balance and relationship, and strives for harmony between polarization, and the Sun there makes for a particularly strong placement in composite charts. Your relationship is likely to exude good taste, elegance and charm. You are natural partners for each other, and your preferred mode of living is in relationship, and in abiding connection with others that you meet through life. An excellent outlet for your joint love of beauty is in artistic pursuits of all kinds. In a romantic relationship, this is obviously a very good sign for a committed partnership. Intimacy stands as an exceedingly high value for you both, as does the principal of justice and fairness between you. You will likely go out of your way to avoid a quarrel. If and when conflict arises, the best course of action for you will be to stop immediately and take space for a while.. As a partnership, you may find that you have a tendency to understand and support both sides of a dispute. You may also find that together you have a hard time making a decision. In a romantic context, you two may be unconventional in the way you express your sense of play and your sexuality. Children are likely to be a source of great interest but you may have difficulties in giving them steady warmth and affection. You can be very creative together, especially in the arts. You are fortunate in being able to support each other in the exploration and development of your individual talents. This placement supports innovation at the cost of stability, but stability may be overrated when things are this interesting. In any case, your relationship benefits from developing follow-through, focus and self-discipline in order to successfully complete what gets inspired at the start.

Composite Uranus in Sagittarius (or the ninth house) brings to your relationship an original and inventive cast of mind, with strong intuitive powers. There is likely to be an inherent love of philosophy and higher learning. With this placement you two tend to share strong religious, or religious-like beliefs, although perhaps expressed in an unconventional manner. In a romantic relationship you have a harmonious higher mind connection with each other and will always have plenty to discuss. You are likely to enjoy the exploration of new horizons together, either mentally or through travel, and you might need to be ready to jump into the car at a moment's notice. You share a powerful sense of optimism and a tendency for reckless behavior at times, since together you may not always look before you leap, and you benefit from exercising caution when it is appropriate to do so. As a partnership you possess high ideals, and share a capacity to visualize new possibilities rather than accept an outmoded status quo. true goals. There is great tension represented by the focal planet or planets in your chart, where conflicting parts of your personality attain their focus and peak of energy, and you may observe compulsive behavior in the area of life represented here.

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

The composite Moon in the Eighth House signals a relationship with an intense blend of energies that can generate a pervasive fascination between you. You may find that you and your partner stimulate each other in an evocative way. If the relationship has enough safety, you can offer each other a profound opportunity to reveal and release subconscious emotional drives. In a romantic relationship there is likely to be a strong and magnetic pull of sexual intensity between you, which is really about deeply sharing with each other. This dynamic touches so many sensitive and concealed parts of your personality that it cannot be taken lightly. Be aware that when you two play in your shared waters, you are likely to have to navigate the undercurrents that get set off by the interaction, such as compulsion, obsession, guilt, anxiety or even anger, depending on what each of you has inside yourself to discover. You may also compensate for overdoing in the area of life represented by the focal point, by leaning toward the empty pattern element opposite the focal point, seeking to balance your activity. The lesson of this planetary aspect pattern is in learning to use your considerable energy wisely in the pursuit of your true goals. There is great tension represented by the focal planet or planets in your chart, where conflicting parts of your personality attain their focus and peak of energy, and you may observe compulsive behavior in the area of life represented here.

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

The composite Mercury in the Second House indicates a relationship with easy communication around the issues of finances and security needs. You are likely to be in agreement and communicate well regarding your joint values. Together, you have an innate sense of what you most need in order to survive. In a romantic context, you will find that you get along well in the practical concerns of managing a household together. Your excellent communication around your resources makes it easier to deal with the daily rigors of budgets and allocation. As a partnership you have talent for dealing with accounting or property rights issues. You could also team up successfully to earn money from anything involving the written word, education or finance. You have an ability for legal wrangling that can take you far if you decide to go into any form of business together. You make the most of whatever resources you have, and find it congenial to discuss money matters with each other.

Composite Mercury in Libra brings a positive mental attitude to your relationship, with a good sense of graceful communication. You two tend to be diplomatic with each other and with those around you, and are often quite aware of the effect that your words will have on others. You have terrific judgment and sensitivity most days, with an occasional propensity to lapse to the other extreme once in a while. When together, you tend to express your ideas with balance and fairness to all sides of an issue. Your joint awareness of differing points of view can however make it difficult for you to come to a decision as a partnership. Your relationship brings out a highly developed sense of artistry between you, with a strong tendency toward perfectionism. A shared living space will generally be aesthetically pleasing to both of you. You benefit when you stay as aware as possible of your shared propensity for being fussy with each other and those around you, and learn to lean on your core values of balance and fairness.

You have a T-Square in your chart. With this planetary aspect pattern, in which three planets or conjunctions are in square with one another, you have a high degree of motivation and drive. Your energies are most easily and habitually expressed by the energy of the focal point, the middle of the T-Square. You may also compensate for overdoing in the area of life represented by the focal point, by leaning toward the empty pattern element opposite the focal point, seeking to balance your activity. The lesson of this planetary aspect pattern is in learning to use your considerable energy wisely in the pursuit of your true goals. There is great tension represented by the focal planet or planets in your chart, where conflicting parts of your personality attain their focus and peak of energy, and you may observe compulsive behavior in the area of life represented here.

Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.

Chiron in the Fifth House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for you to face deeply held wounds with regard to your vital force and expressing yourselves in a magnetic way. With this placement, one or both of you may have experienced pain around your sense of who you are and how you express your individual self-hood, both within the relationship and out in the world. This relationship will be an important factor in your on-going exploration of these issues within yourself, and a trigger for future healing. One or both of you likely have a deep desire to share your unique sensibility with others and move them or enlighten them in some way. Yet you may find yourselves thwarted in your attempts to shine, perhaps because of painful experiences in your formative relationships in which you were put down or made to feel insecure. These experiences may cause you to be wary of actually coming out with who you really are. You may feel a strong desire to be your own unique and independent self, fully in touch with your inner being, but fail in the actual event. You may even have experienced radical blockages, such as accidents or other "acts of God" that have prevented you from achieving your full creative potential. You will continue to have painful experiences as long as these issues and their deep-seated emotions remain unconscious within your psyche. You may feel a need to help others in achieving their goals, rather than yourself. You may even make a career of helping others in this way, leading them toward the path that you might have taken yourself. This is valid as long as it comes from a place free of resentment and unfulfilled promises. It is important to try to become conscious of all your inner dynamics as you explore your life's path. Then you can shine out as a beacon for others, and achieve dramatic results in your own life in ways you would never have dreamed possible.

Composite Chiron in Capricorn (or the Tenth House) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding your vital force to act with authority and make a responsible contribution to society. In this relationship, you may find yourself somewhat rebellious of authority, while compulsively drawn to it at the same time. You may begin to be aware of experiences in your life where you had to knuckle under against your will or, conversely, where felt you had to over-exert your authority with others in a way that left them feeling oppressed. Perhaps the compulsion to be in authority that you are feeling in this relationship arose in your childhood, from a time when you were too forcefully controlled. Everyone has a basic need to be in control, and if we develop a distrust of authority as a result of early experiences, we tend to strike first rather than wait to be pushed around. These unconscious patterns can also manifest in the relationship as a penchant to achieve, only to feel ambivalent about subsequent success. This relationship may mirror ways that you felt pushed to success by the important parental figures of your childhood, without getting a chance to find your own true destiny. You may experience low self-esteem, seeking notoriety as a way of making up for feelings of worthlessness that live somewhere below your conscious level of reasoning. In order to avoid these traps, it is good to take advantage of this relationship to get in conscious touch with your hidden feelings, and bring them into the light to explore them in detail. Once you have begun this process, it will continue as a natural part of your shared growth, allowing you both to wield a more conscious and integrated form of personal power as you move through the world together.

Important Features

Composite Jupiter in Libra, in the Third House

Jupiter in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will find mutual good fortune and faith in positive outcomes.

Jupiter in the Third House (or sign) magnifies the charming, talkative, and clever aspects of your relationship and promotes growth through communication. You tend to move in similar rhythms through your day and enjoy your time together, whether it is scheduled or free time that you share. Although you two may become somewhat scattered in each other's company, you share an inquisitiveness about life and an appetite to learn more and more regarding just about any subject. In a romantic relationship, your penchant for good communication in written or verbal forms brings a great deal of interest to your conversations with each other. You will never tire of things to talk about, and may get into a joint writing project of some kind. Your relationship also grows through travel, intellectual pursuits of all kinds and any sort of effort spent on education.

Optimistic and changeable, you two see the value and benefit of many different pursuits, so that it may be wise for you to narrow down and attempt greater focus. You also benefit when you think matters through together before making decisions and learn to keep your own council. When you are operating at your highest level your relationship's tendency toward superficiality and the scattering of your energies becomes the cultivation of depth as well as breadth of awareness and a universal curiosity that leads to higher wisdom.

Composite Jupiter in Libra (or the seventh house) emphasizes the refined and idealistic aspects of your relationship. You two tend to experience the relationship itself as the true source of your shared happiness and this placement is one of the very best for romantic relationships. Together, you work well with other people, and may become known for your fairness. You each grow when you engage in these kinds of activities. You may form the type of partnership that will make a habit of championing both sides of a dispute and making sure that the underdog has his say. You may also be outwardly-directed as a partnership, and concerned with what others might think. Ina romantic relationship, you are likely to find enjoyment everywhere together. Your relationship grows through exploring art and beauty wherever you may find it. You benefit when you develop your shared capacity to stop and smell the flowers and follow your energy to serve each other and the relationship, so that rather than pursuing the socially derived mandate to steam ahead, you allow your focus to be on simply getting your boat down the river.

Angular Planets

Composite Saturn in Aquarius, in the Sixth House

Saturn in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter limitations and build long-lasting success through trials of accomplishment.

Saturn in the Sixth House (or sign) brings a deepening and concentration to your mental powers with each other and to the discriminative faculties of your relationship. You do not shrink from working hard together, and you inspire each other to put extra effort into completing a task you have set for yourselves. It may feel natural for one of you to work in a subordinate capacity. There also may be subconscious fears regarding self-worth that spur you on, and that may come up for healing between you. This is a great placement for a business partnership, or any relationship where hard work is required and long-term effort carefully applied. You both learn, over time, the importance of attending to each detail regarding your shared projects as well as to your shared emotional life. In a romantic connection, you two are good at handling minutiae together; but you may have to become aware of not getting lost in the inconsequential. You also may need to remember to let up on that discerning eye when it comes to paying attention to each other's heart. There also may be strong focus on health issues in your partnership. Together, you are seriousminded and make an excellent working team, whether for personal matters or in contributing something to the larger world.

Composite Saturn in Aquarius (or the eleventh house) indicates that in your relationship there may be a blockage or a concentration of energy around socializing in groups and relating to the larger community. This is likely to become an important focus, and over time may create a powerful bond between you. You also have a strong goal orientation as a partnership. In a romantic connection, you will always have a clear idea of where the relationship is headed. There may also be difficulties that you encounter together in relating to groups. This relationship can exacerbate problems that you each have in feeling as though you fully belong to a particular group, or you may draw back from the circles in which you participate together from a fear of not being fully accepted. On the other hand, this placement of Saturn can also serve as a bridge between you, making a larger whole out of the amalgam of two kindred souls, and enabling you to make your way to higher states of awareness regarding the world around you. One of the main lessons of this relationship is to transform a narrow view of social acceptance on a personal level into a broader vision, one in which you both can meaningfully participate in creating a sharing society that has transcended the current level of materialism.

Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Composite Sun in square with Mars

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between composite Sun and Mars brings a rash quality to your relationship, and a creative tension. You may find that you are restless together, and that your individual tempers quicken. You may trigger each other so easily that you then act out impulsively, perhaps against your own better thinking. You will also likely find in yourselves a tendency toward argument based on a deep-seated need to be understood. On the other hand, your relationship possesses a forceful drive with the possibility of accomplishing great things. You two will never want for lack of excitement, and with each other you find

inspiration to take risks you would not take on your own. It benefits you to learn to temper your strong physical drive together with calmness and discretion, and to develop creative outlets that make good use of your joint fire.

Composite Venus in trine with Ascendant

Ascendant

The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects

When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

- Conjunction 0° ± 8 degrees
- Opposition 180° ± 8 degrees
- Trine 120° ± 8 degrees
- Square 90° ± 8 degrees
- Sextile 60° ± 6 degrees
- Inconjunct 150° ± 4 degrees

Chart Comparison

An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart

An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope

Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."

Midheaven

The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.

Natal

From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.

Nodes

The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.

Planets

In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.

Transits

Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
